McQuade Tournament: Cheryl needs to know who is working and where. Beth/Jo/Danielle will be working at the Kelley Shack. Sue/Joey/Jessica will be working at the McQuade shack. Brenda will help cover where needed. Brenda will deliver softballs to the shacks. Softballs will be limited, make sure that umpires are using one old and one new per game; not 2 new balls every game. Beth will take her label maker to Kelley. Sue will take one to McQuade. Danielle said Cheryl said they will not be making name tags this year. Tell the gatekeeper you are a volunteer if they ask. Sue will check to see if there are any softballs available, either from state or maybe Cody still has some stored.

League Information: Sue will email the team managers regarding state tournament participation. To be included in the email: No drinking during league play! Uniforms must be worn for league. League home run limit is 2 for all divisions, final adds must be made by this Friday (do not mail them make sure to contact Danielle or Sue to make arrangements to either drop them off or have them picked up.), teams can only bat up to 11 players in any tournament play, pick up player rules for state and pick up player rules for invitational tournaments. A copy of the roster revision form will be attached to the email.

State Classification meeting will be July 9<sup>th</sup> in Jamestown. If teams feel they want their team reclassified, please write a detailed email and send to [BWSSA@live.com](mailto:BWSSA@live.com) before June 30<sup>th</sup>. Teams whose classification is higher due to a dual player and want to play in state at a lower level without that dual player, can complete a ND tournament only roster and pay the \$65 fee to register that team at state so essentially the team will be registered as 2 separate teams at the state level. The tournament roster will need to be classified by the league rep and submitted with the fee to the state office. Sue asked if Danielle was able to get into the state portal as we need to request a certificate of insurance to Parks and Rec. Danielle said she had not been able to get into the portal, Sue said she will contact RC to see if he can help.

National Tournament: Ethan from Parks and Rec said Bismarck will be hosting a Men's D national on Labor Day weekend. He wanted to know if anyone would be interested in being on the committee. No one wanted to be on the committee, but would be willing to help if they are available that weekend.
