June 14, 2016

We discussed team classifications and watching teams at McQuade to see if there are any teams that may need to be reclassified prior to the state classification meeting in July. Pleasant Ridge asked to be reclassified and it was decided they could be reclassified- Cody would contact them and let them know their request was approved.

There has been a lot of confusion about the home run limit in league on Thursday nights. The home run limit for league is 2 homeruns for all leagues. Sue Heilman will send out an email to all managers and Mike Wolf to let them know this.

Player's uniforms is again a problem, several teams have players showing up without their uniforms. Sue will send out an email to the managers to let them know that uniforms are required by our bylaws and if players aren't wearing a uniform, they should not be allowed to play. An email was sent out the managers and Mike Wolf.

Final players adds are due in the state office by June 21. State tournament fees are due June 25th for any teams interested in going to state.

Sue Heilman proposed that the masters Divisions be changed for this year into 4 divisions for better representation by teams classification --- Division 1 would be over 30 pts, Division 2 would be 30 to 21 pts; Division 3 would be 20 to 11 pts and Division 4 is 10 pts. – with a D player = 4pts, rec 1 player = 3 pts, rec 2 player =2 pts and rec 3 player = 1pt. All agreed.

McQuade – Cody will contact Riley to make sure shacks are cleaned out before the tournament. Leann will be out of town until Sunday –Most everyone else will be there for awhile on Friday so the shack should be covered - Sue and Joey will handle the Mcquade Complex – Jo Weisbeck will work at Kelley – People playing at Kelley will check in to help as needed when they aren't playing.
