

## Minutes for BWSSA Manager's Meeting

February 28, 2018

Minutes from the October 11<sup>th</sup> Manager's meeting were read by Beth Deeter. Motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Jason Farstad, seconded by Nikki Brunelle.

Old Business: update on the Cottonwood addition, fund have been secured and they should break ground the spring – hopefully the diamonds will be ready for use in 2020.

New Business: Beth brought up that Player's fees should be on 1 check or money order.

Sue Heilman reported that we will be a sponsor for the Play Ball event being hosted as part of the McQuade Tournament in conjunction with the Minnesota Twins and Bismarck Larks. We will not be asked for monetary support just to put the information on our website and facebook pages and spread the word to the community. This is a free event for kids that will be held on Thursday night and followed by a softball game at the Bismarck Baseball field between the American Patriots team (previously known as the Wounded Warriors ) and a Bismarck Celebrity team.

Cody discussed teams that placed first or second would probably be moved up --- teams that placed first on Monday, Wednesday or in Pioneer league on Tuesday could change night that there team plays. Other things taken into consideration for league placement is if your team has had a major roster change. Teams will start the season with the same classification that they ended with last year. If you feel your team should be reclassified, the manager should submit a detailed letter giving reasons you wish to have your teams classification changed. A team's classification does not necessarily dictate which league your team is placed in.

Cody also reported the state tournament dates and sites.

Beth reported the next meeting date will be March 26<sup>th</sup> – same place, same time --- Player's fees and city rosters will be collected – She also told manager's there was a checklist available showing when the meetings were and what would be collected at each meeting.
